Ongoing information sharing:

- Carol has funding for a **series of research symposia to take place in Toronto and Chapel Hill** that will bring together experts in adolescent health and youth development with occupational health researchers/practitioners in the field of young worker health and safety. The first one will take place in Spring 2007. She will keep us posted on how we can be involved.
- Through the OSHA-funded Young Worker Safety Resource Center (Chris and Diane), four **conference calls** will be held this year, to share ideas, and pursue possible joint projects. These will be announced on the national yw listserv. The group brainstormed the following topics:
 - Update re developing OSHA-10 teaching resources relevant for young workers
 - Involving youth in promoting yw health and safety
 - Linking our work with labor/COSH groups
 - Model employer programs
 - Working with parent groups
 - Linking with experts in adolescent health/youth development
- Diane will explore possibility of setting up **e-community/web-based opportunities for sharing information**. What's possible at UC? Carol can pursue through UNC if not possible at UC Berkeley.
- We agreed to plan an **all-day meeting next year before APHA (Sat?, Nov 3rd, 2007, Washington D.C.)** to bring together educators, activists and researchers interested in young worker health and safety, to share resources, new projects, etc. Please contact Diane or Mary if you're interested in helping to plan this meeting.
